Want to learn more about your local area and help reduce flood risk? We will provide all free training, support and guidance for the project to:

- Monitor, record and clear debris from burns
- Identify and record invasive non-native plant species



Aim: The Flood Warden Volunteer will choose and monitor their identified site(s) throughout the year on a regular basis to monitor and record what you see on the day including:

- Date inspected and cleared
- Take before and after photos of debris
- Inspection comments
- Any invasive non-native plant species observed

Monitoring sites include:

1. Menstrie
2. Alva
3. Tillicoultry
4. Dollar



The Council has its own cyclical watercourse inspection & clearance system, but information gathered from volunteer Flood Wardens will be recorded to inform flood risk maintenance actions.
